Each year, Managing IP's research analysts obtain information from thousands of firms, IP practitioners, and their clients through interviews, email, and online surveys. Before compiling the shortlists, the researchers evaluate work data supplied by firms and review publicly available information like court and IP office records, focusing on work done or concluded in the previous year, particularly looking for case studies that are of great significance to clients and/or IP law and practice.

The Managing IP Awards programme recognises remarkable IP achievements and developments in the last year. Now in its 20th year, the awards cover several intellectual property practice areas and more than 50 jurisdictions.
